Michele Brown, a resident from the Jupiter Highlands assessment area, asked that the project be stopped and inquired whether there was a legal option due to the financial situation of the neighborhoods.

Eleanor Mesteller inquired about the cost to hookup from the road to the house; she also asked whether a delay could take place if the homeowner had a good working septic tank.

Dr. Arrington stated that the homeowner would have until November 2010 to pay or the homeowner could pay in property taxes of \$568 per year.

Glenn Mesteller asked about empty lots and was told the lot would be assessed but there would be no connection charge.


Dr. Arrington wanted to remind the homeowners that this decision was for the health of the environment and the entire county.

5. ADJOURNMENT


Chairman Whalen adjourned the Public Hearing at 7:20 P.M.
