

River Center Hosts "A Night on the Loxahatchee"

Jupiter, Florida -- The River Center will host "A Night on the Loxahatchee" featuring a cocktail soiree and special preview of the Loxahatchee River Photography Exhibit on Saturday, April 17 from 6pm to 9pm. The River Center is located at Burt Reynolds Park in Jupiter.

Guests will enjoy special tours of the center and live entertainment, along with a special preview of the traveling exhibition of the winning photographs of the Loxahatchee River photo contest. There also will be hors d'oeuvres, wine and a silent auction. The cost to attend is a donation of \$50 per person/non-member, \$40 per person/members, which benefits this amazing environmental education resource.

The River Center traces the Loxahatchee River from its pristine freshwater reaches to a teeming estuary, and eventually to the Jupiter Inlet where it spills into the Atlantic Ocean. The center presents some of the largest aquatic exhibits in the area with an interactive exploration of the river, diverse wildlife and its majestic environmental value. In addition, guests learn where their water comes from, how it is consumed and recycled back into the community. There are multi-media and live aquarium exhibits, and a touch tank teeming with aquatic life.

The River Center is a program of the Loxahatchee River District to further awareness about the Loxahatchee River and to foster support for its preservation.
