LOXAHATCHEE RIVER ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL DISTRICT REGULAR MEETING - MINUTES APRIL 17, 2014

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Rostock called the Regular Meeting of April 17, 2014 to order at 7:03 P.M.

2. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

A. ROLL CALL

B. PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

D. Deep Bed Sand Filters Engineering Contract Award
